

Suspension, Steering, and Drive Axle Parts Replacement Applicable to All Volkswagen Models

Volkswagen suspension, steering, and drive axle components may be constructed of special alloys that include aluminum, nodular iron, and special steel alloys.

VWoA does not support the use of recycled parts, commonly known as "junk yard" parts, since there would be no clear indications of previous damage to these parts.

Crack/fatigue damage can only be detected by sophisticated testing such as dye penetrant, zyglow, magnaflux, or x-ray. Alignment of critical surfaces cannot be checked by visual inspection only, but require the proprietary design blueprint.

WARNING: Recycled suspension, steering, and drive axle parts may not meet the specifications of Genuine Volkswagen Suspension, Steering, and Drive Axle Parts, and are not an acceptable method of repair on any Volkswagen vehicle.

Recycled suspension, steering, and drive axle parts, or any suspension, steering, and drive axle parts, are not approved by VWoA, and may cause unsafe vehicle operation and performance, including loss of control, which may result in injury or death.
